WEDNESDAY 26TH JULY

11:00 - "Chalk and Cheese" - Bridhaven Nursing Home

The local band of troubadours kick off the Festival with a varied selection of music.

12:30 - Opening Of Gerard O'Meara Photographic Exhibition - The Globe Cafe

A selection of images covering portraits, fashion, nature, landscape and groups of people captured by Gerard over a period of 65 years behind the lens.

14:00 - The Sopranos - St Patricks Boys National School

A folk fusion of Irish and African drum and songs. BAND:


